



## TO BE ELIGIBLE TO STAND FOR ELECTION

Under Clause 6.1 of the Trust Deed, a candidate must:

- ✓ be a **member** aged **20 years or over**
- ✓ **meet the requirements** for being an officer of a charitable entity under the **Charities Act 2005** (see below)
- ✓ be **nominated** by a Tupuna Whānau Representative of Te Tii (Waitangi) B3 Trust (noting that a Tupuna Whānau Representative can nominate themselves)

## General Notes:

---

- Nomination materials must be lodged together and must be with the Returning Officer or an electoral official by the close of nominations at **12 noon on Friday 20 March 2026**.

- Nominations received after 12 noon on Friday 20 March 2026 will not be accepted.
- Each nomination may be accompanied by a candidate profile statement of 150 words maximum (template attached), and a recent passport-sized colour photograph. Candidates should be aware that this information, along with their name as it appears on the nomination paper, will be made publicly available, and included with voting papers.
- If only three (3) valid nominations are received, then those candidates will be declared duly elected. If four (4) or more valid nominations are received, an election will be conducted by postal and online ballot, with voting opening on Monday 23 March 2026 and closing at 12 noon on Thursday 30 April 2026.

## Qualifications of officers of charitable entities (section 16, Charities Act 2005):

---

A candidate for election must **not** be:

- an individual who is an undischarged bankrupt;
- an individual who is under the age of 16 years;
- an individual who, or a body corporate that, has been convicted of a crime involving dishonesty (within the meaning of section 2(1) of the Crimes Act 1961) or tax evasion or other offence under section 143B of the Tax Administration Act 1994 within the last 7 years;
- an individual who is prohibited from being a director or promoter of, or being concerned or taking part in the management of, an incorporated or unincorporated body under the Companies Act 1993, the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013, or the Takeovers Act 1993;
- an individual who, or a body corporate that, is disqualified from being an officer of a charitable entity under section 31(4) of the Charities Act 2005;
- an individual who is subject to a property order made under the Protection of Personal and Property Rights Act 1988, or whose property is managed by a trustee corporation under section 32 of that Act (this relates to people who are not fully able to manage their affairs);
- a body corporate that is being wound up, is in liquidation or receivership, or is subject to statutory management under the Corporations (Investigation and Management) Act 1989;
- in relation to any particular entity, an individual who, or a body corporate that, does not comply with any qualifications for officers contained in the rules of that entity.
